We have Teaching Assistants on our doors each morning, they are able to pass on messages for you to class teachers. Mrs Vinall, based in The Drey, is often available from 8.30am to discuss any concerns. Class teachers are usually available at the end of the day and the office can make appointments for you to meet with one of the senior leaders, Mrs Knoll, Mrs Sharpe or myself. You can also catch up with me when I am on the playground at the start and end of the day.
