Thank you to all members of our community for their continued support when following the routines and systems on our school site. Following the news that Gosport is now in Tier 2 we are continuing with our current risk assessment. This means that one way system, reduced numbers of adults on the school site and an expectation to wear masks when entering our school grounds will continue.

As we move into the wetter, colder time of the year please ensure your child is well prepared for school. This includes having a warm, waterproof coat, sensible footwear (they can leave wellies in school if that helps) and hats, gloves and scarves. The government advice to schools is that we ensure our classrooms are well ventilated, this means that some windows are open as well as some doors. It is therefore important that children wear layers to school to keep them warm. On PE days please ensure your child is wearing a PE kit that is suitable for outdoor PE. Our PE includes dark tracksuit bottoms or leggings and a plain white t-shirt, children will also require a hoodie or jumper to wear. Football shirts and kits are not part of our PE kit, please save these to wear at home.

In our recent parent survey parents reported that they are really keen to engage in learning at home. To address this we are currently updating our curriculum section of our new website (https://rowner.gfmat.org/) this will include further information about what your child is learning in class and some suggested activities for you to complete at home.
