Expectations for live lessons

We want these lessons to feel like school, therefore we ask for the following:

- Children wear a school uniform top - this causes less on screen distractions and gets everyone in the right frame of mind for learning. Please ensure any hoods are down, as they would be in class.
- Children are not eating during these sessions - they will have lots of breaks for this.
- Children are in a suitable space when learning - it is ok to be sat on a bed, but not in it.
- Children do not have backgrounds on as this slows down the system.
- As much as possible we would like cameras on unless having them off has been agreed with the team.
- Please be aware when a child is in a lesson they will have their mics on, these do pick up background noises and conversations.

Clubs and societies

Our Year 5 children (and adults) have successfully led our after school clubs and societies. So far over 60 children have engaged in these activities and the feedback suggests they are really enjoying them!
